Air Resource Management and National Ozone Unit of the Ministry of Environment invites **Expression of Interest (EOI)** from qualified and experienced local consultants to undertake the above consultancy.

The Project Consultant Procurement Committee (CPCP) on behalf of the Air Resource Management and National Ozone Unit of Ministry of Environment, hereby invites eligible consultants to indicate their interest in providing the services described herein. Interested consultants must provide information indicating that they are qualified and experienced to perform the above consultancy.

The assignment aims to develop comprehensive, practical, and illustrated guideline for practitioners/technicians in RAC and MAC sectors to enhance safe, energy-efficient, and environmentally sound refrigerant units and systems servicing practices in alignment with the Obligations of Montreal Protocol, national and international standards, and Green Technical Vocational Education and Training (TVET) policy.

Scope of Work:

- Review existing Codes of Good Practices, relevant national and international standards (SLS, ASHRAE, ISO, EN, IEC), Green TVET policy, National Competency Standards, curricula, and training materials.

- Consult key stakeholders, including Tertiary Vocational Education Commission (TVEC), National Apprentice and Industrial Training Authority (NAITA), Vocational Training Authority (VTA), Ceylon German Technical Training Institute (CGTTI), Department of Technical Education and Training (DTET), University of Vocational Technology (UNIVOTEC) industry associations, and the National Ozone Unit.
- Identify key thematic areas for technicians/practitioners (e.g., refrigerant handling, leak testing, recovery, safety, and energy-efficient servicing).
- Integration of gender mainstreaming.
- Conduct one stakeholder workshop and one validation workshop.
- Provide recommendations for awareness programmes and integration into national training systems.
- Develop a user-friendly, illustrated guideline for technicians and practitioners.

Duration

The assignment will be carried out over **3 months** from the date of contract signing.

Qualifications of the consultancy:

- Bachelor's degree in Mechanical Engineering or Diploma in Refrigeration and Air Conditioning technology, or a related technical field.
- Post graduate qualifications will be an added advantage
- Minimum 3 years of professional experience in the RAC and MAC sector, including servicing, maintenance, or technical oversight.
- Proven experience in developing training materials, technical guidelines, manuals, or standard operating procedures for technicians/practitioners.
- Knowledge of TVET systems and NVQ framework.
- Knowledge of gender mainstreaming will be an added advantage.
- Strong analytical, report-writing, communication, and facilitation skills.
- Ability to simplify technical content into user-friendly, illustrated guidelines.

Selection Method:

Consultants will be selected in accordance with the procedures set out in the Guidelines for Selection and Employment of Consultants, published by the National Procurement Agency (NPA) following the Quality and Cost Based Selection (QCBS) method.
