Establishment of Measurement, Reporting & Verification (MRV) Assessment Framework for Agriculture, Forestry and Other Land Use (AFOLU) sector in Sri Lanka

The Democratic Socialist Republic of Sri Lanka has received a grant from the Global Environmental Facility and intends to apply part of this grant for Establishment of Measurement, Reporting & Verification Assessment Framework (MRV) for Agriculture, Forestry and Other Land Use (AFOLU) sector in Sri Lanka.

Sri Lanka is a party to the United Nations Framework Convention on Climate Change (UNFCCC) since 1993 and to the Paris Agreement since 2016. Article 13 of the Paris Agreement indicates the need for an Enhanced Transparency Framework (ETF) to further enhance the transparency of the climate actions. Modalities, Procedures and Guidelines (MPGs) for ETF that have been adopted by the UNFCCC. Accordingly, the Ministry of Environment, being the national focal point to the UNFCCC has develop a Web-based Measurement, Reporting & Verification system and need to be introduced an assessment framework to monitor it.

The Ministry Consultants Procurement Committee on behalf of the Secretary to the Ministry of Environment invites proposal from consultancy firms/teams those who have following experiences for the consultancy service on Establishment of MRV Assessment Framework for AFOLU sector in Sri Lanka.
